- Influence future protection for sites and buildings through national designation

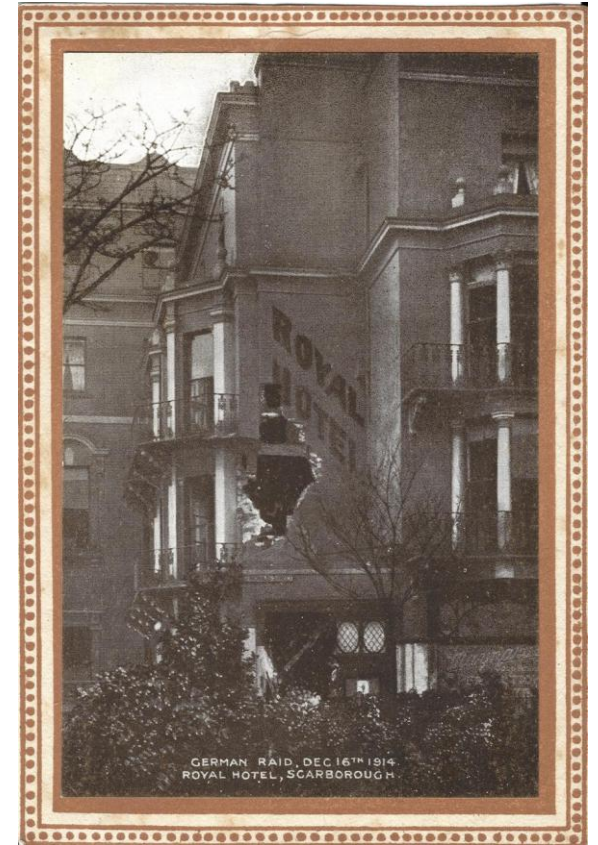
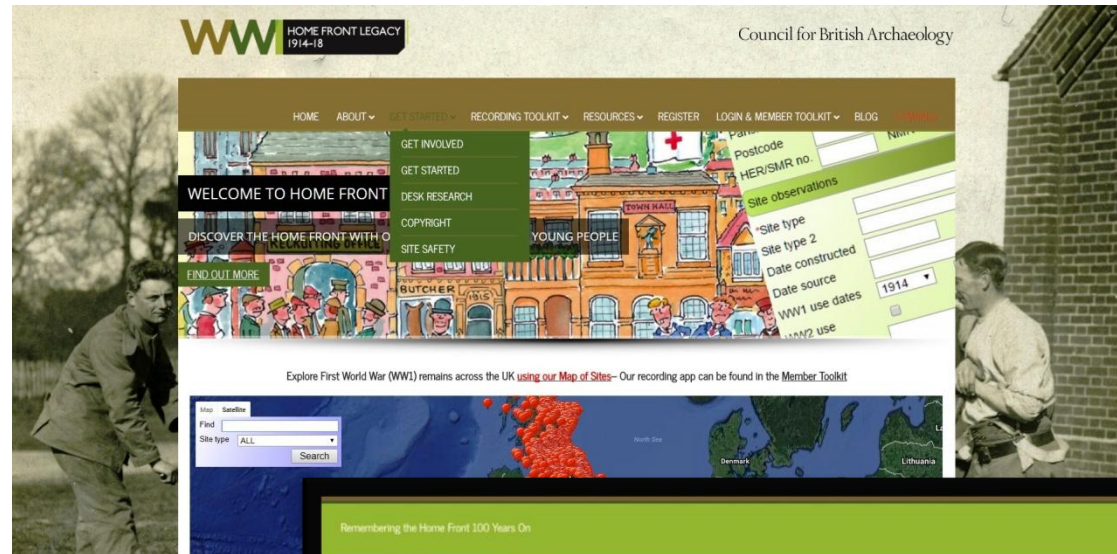

Home Front Legacy provides an online toolkit for recording the Home Front sites, structures and buildings

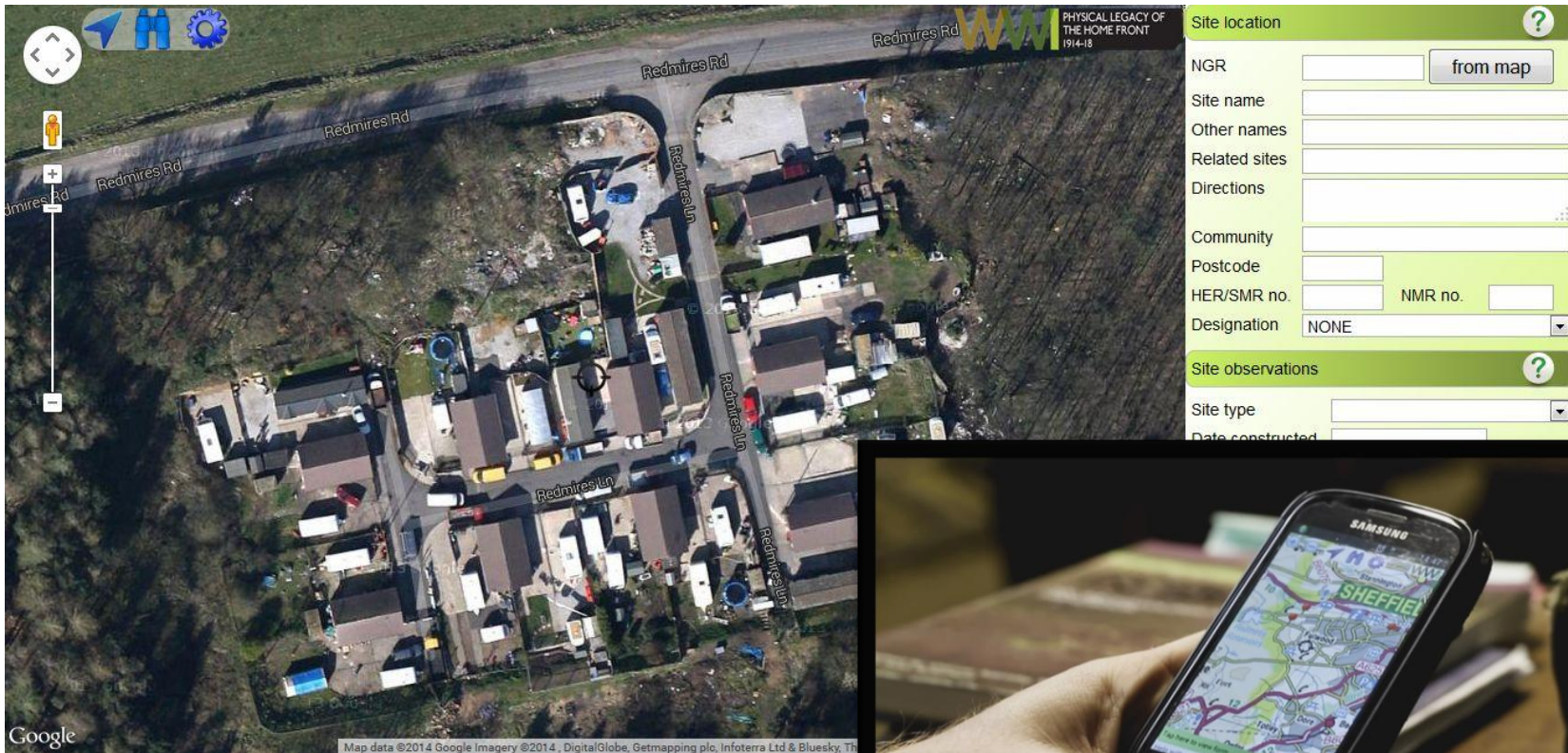

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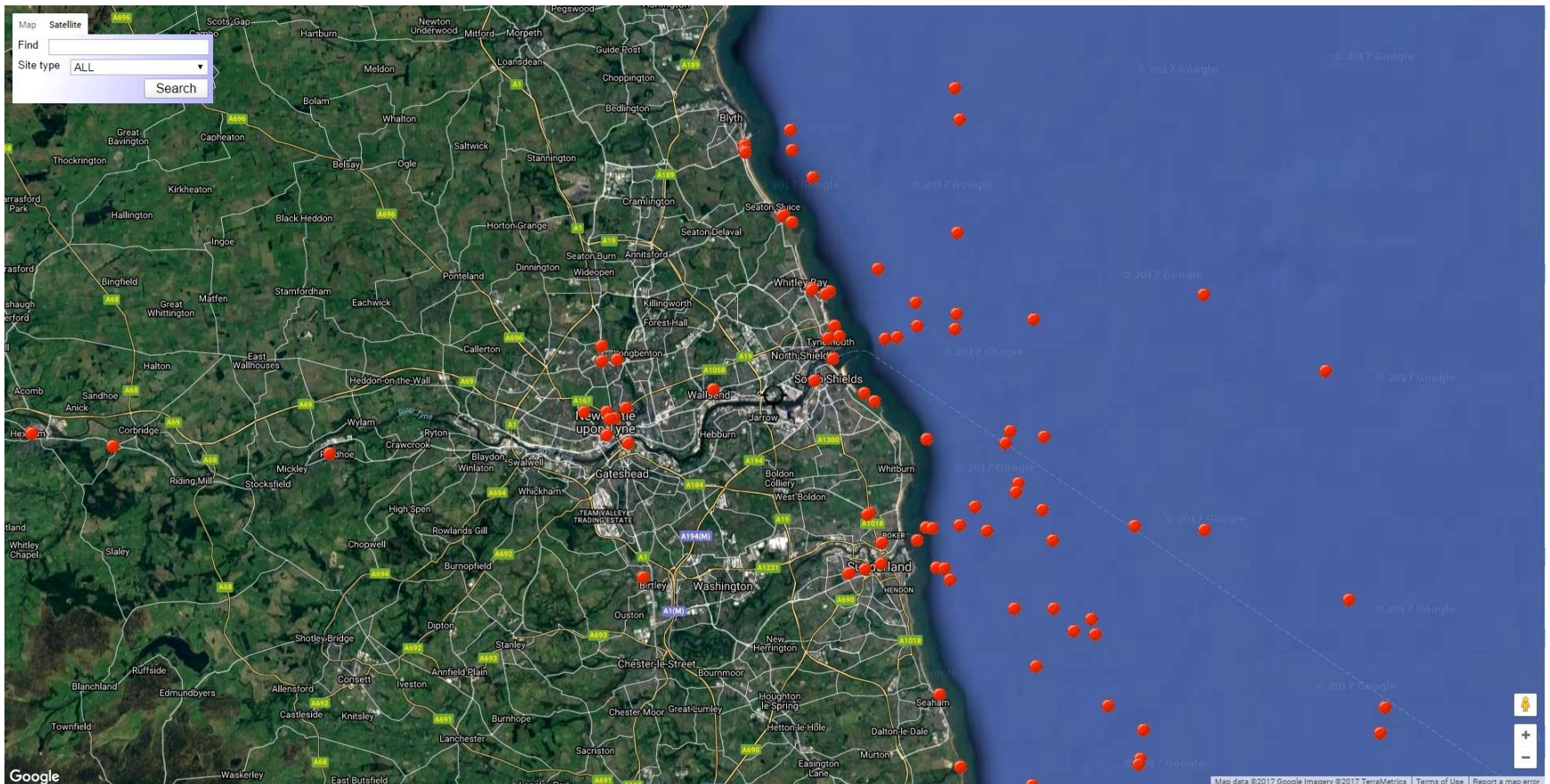
Home Front Legacy recording app





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Home Front Legacy 'Map of Sites'



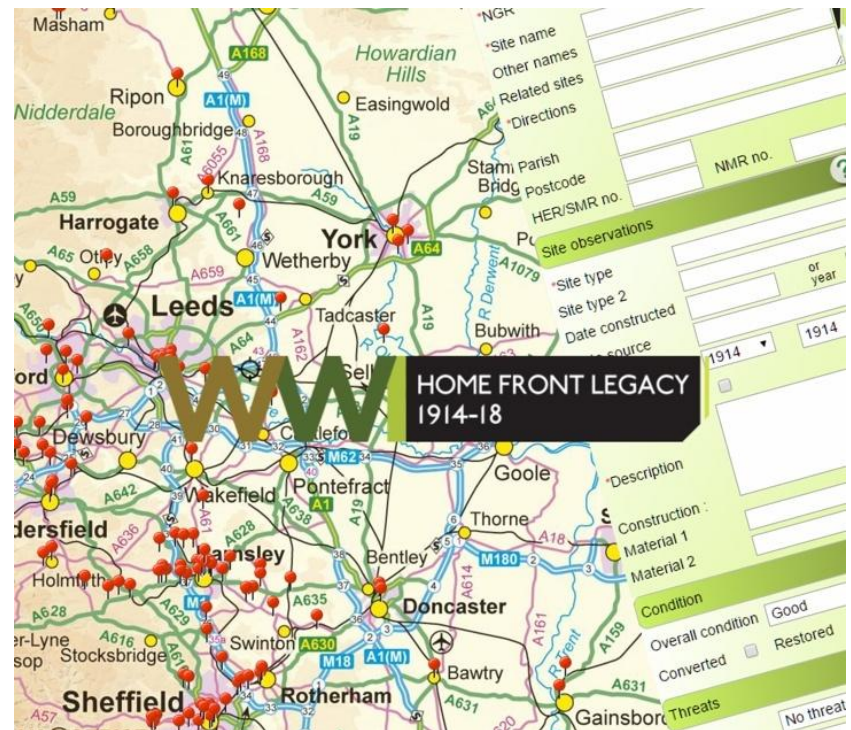
